- Treasurer's report:
 - \$450 prepaid for future show awards
 - Available cash \$3650
 - Revenue \$430 from program advertising
 - April show only \$56 loss

 - Judge will make own travel arrangements.
 - Weanling/yearling classes will be included if enough horses
 - Class list is shorter, freestyle reining added, trail will be in main arena at the end of the afternoon session
 - Awards discussed, possible halters, neck ribbons
 - Mary has a color guard and flag presentation planned for the Saturday evening program. Also, someone will sing the national anthem. .
 - A concession has been booked. No food or drinks in the barns due to facility concerns about rodents
 - RV/stall reservations will be made through the show Office/entry form
 - Stalls must be cleaned before leaving, or pay additional \$20 per stall

- Program advertising going well (\$460 so far). Revenue above expenses will be applied to future shows/programs, members encouraged to seek sponsors/advertisers.
- TWHs will show at the end of the Fair September 1, 2, and 3 (Friday-Sunday). Amateur and open classes will be offered for TWHs.
 - The club may do a flag presentation Saturday night (9/2)
- New Business:
 - The club participates in a bottle drop program (in Oregon only). Get blue bottle bags and tags from Nancy O'Dell so credit on returns goes to the club.
 - The club offers “recycling” of show clothes for members – contact Nancy O'Dell
