

Please join us for the 10th Annual NCWHA Oktoberfest Horse Show October 20-22, 2017. As usual, there are a few changes to the show and we hope you will read through the premium to make yourselves aware of changes to the show. We are pleased that again the show will be held at the beautiful **Equestrian Center at Rolling Hills Casino** in Corning, California! We had a lot of positive comments about the facilities and hope you can enjoy what they have to offer again this year!

We are pleased to announce that in 2017, Oktoberfest will be unaffiliated. We will be using an older version (2014) of the Walking Horse Owners' Association rulebook. Premium Changes

Please review the class schedule, as several changes have been made from years past.

(Revised 9/11/2017)

Unfortunately, due to the increase in expenses for Oktoberfest, the NCWHA board has decided to increase the class fees for some classes. All preliminary rail classes will remain at \$25. Championships class fees have been raised to \$25. Versatility and halter class fees have been raised to \$20. We hope you will understand the money it takes to put on a first class horse show and the need for this increase.

We will again have the Chris Ishmael Memorial Class. This class is in memory and honor of Chris Ishmael, son of Kerry and Candy Ishmael. In 2016, we were thrilled to have 18 entries in this class. A special memorial trophy will be awarded in Chris's memory and honor. All proceeds from this class will again be donated to Mission 22. Entry fees for this class can be tax deductible but will need to be made with a separate payment. If you cannot show in this class, please consider making a donation to Mission 22 in Chris's name. Donations can also be made through the show office.

We are also excited to try a new class. Class #90 is the Add a Class. The office will be open to taking monetary bids as to what this class will be. The winning bidder will be announced Saturday afternoon and can set the class name and requirements. We hope this will bring out some fun and creativity!!!

Versatility High Point Award

The Delight's Hi Tone Perpetual Versatility Hi Point Trophy will again be awarded to the overall hi point versatility horse. A reserve hi point will also be awarded. **No preshow sign up is required**. Points will follow the horse. is a change in the scheduling to try to help the versatility classes not go so late at night. Cowboy Dressage and trail classes will be held **Friday evening** and the rest of the versatility classes will be on Saturday. Gaited Cowboy Dressage tests can be found at http://cowboydressageworld.com/?page_id=194. The TWHBEA Versatility rulebook (2010 and beyond) will be used for all other versatility classes.

NCWHA Members Hi Point

The NCWHA Members Oktoberfest Show Hi Points were well received last year and will continue to be "true" hi points with no class limits. **No pre-sign up is required!** If you are an NCWHA member <u>at the beginning of the show</u>, you are automatically eligible for this program. We will give hi point and reserve hi point awards in Open, Amateur, and Youth divisions. **Points follow the rider.** Because of this, we ask that the rider's information be accurate for each class so points can be correctly assigned. More than one horse can be used to collect points.

Championship Classes

<u>The Golden Ticket Awards</u> proved very popular last year and will again be awarded in 2017. The judge will be given 10 golden tickets. She will be distributing those cards throughout the show to the entries she feels are among the best of the show, regardless of breed or division. <u>These ten entries only will be invited to show back in the Overall Championship Class</u>. All ten entries will be tied and receive ribbon prizes. The champion and reserve champion for the show will be awarded. It is our hope that this will continue to recognize the top horses of the show and encourage them to show back will make it a more exciting and a true overall championship for the show.

Facility Information



Rolling Hills Casino has hotels available on site. The NCWHA has rooms reserved at special show rates-\$89/night (regular room) and \$104/night (suite). Breakfast for two people is included with each room reservation. If you have more than two people in your room, there is a \$10 per person charge. **Call and book your rooms ASAP and be sure to reference the NCWHA event!** Contact Karen Hinton at 530-824-8300 for reservations. There are several other hotels in the Corning area. The hotel closest to the facility is the Holiday Inn Express and Suites. There are also a number of RV spots available, most close to the barns. Hook ups are \$35/night. Contact Rhonda Azevedo for reservations. There will be an onsite food vendor, Coffee Addiction. Golf cart rentals are available for \$25/day. There are only 10 carts available so reserve early! Rolling Hills also has hay and shaving available for purchase on site. Hay is \$15/bale (grass, grass/alfalfa mix, or alfalfa) and shavings are \$7/bale. The facility also has wheelbarrows and pitch forks available for use on site (save room in your trailer!). Oktoberfest is renting the entire facility, including the main indoor show arena, indoor warm up arena, and two outdoor arenas! In addition, golfing is available for \$35/weekday and \$45/weekend. The show closing date not only allows time for the office staff to prepare your entries properly, it also gives us the information needed by the fairgrounds to prepare stalls. By contract we must give them the amount of stalls needed several days before the show. Please try to get your entries in early. Those making entries before October 6, 2017 will be entered into a drawing for a stall fee.
- 2. Any original entries made after the closing date will be assessed the fee of \$35 per horse. No exceptions.
- 3. Payment in full or a signed blank check must be included with the entry to cover all show fees (Make checks payable to NCWHA Oktoberfest). Blank checks may be given to the show office at the show but must be received prior to obtaining the entry show number. Show numbers will not be issued until the entry is complete, **including NCWHA signed releases**.
- 4. Scratches and additions may be made at the show without an additional fee once an original entry is made. In order to prepare for each session, NO ORIGINAL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE START OF EACH SESSION. NO EXCEPTIONS. Please also try to ensure all additions, scratches, and rider changes are made 30 minutes prior to each session.
- 5. Please list all riders for each horse on the entry form. If additional room is needed, please write it on a separate sheet and staple it to the entry form.
- 6. All barns traveling a distance of 500 miles or more round trip will receive a complimentary tack stall from the show.
- 7. Persons failing to pay their bill at the show will be charged a \$50.00 service fee. A \$50 service fee plus additional bank charges will be added to all returned checks. If accounts are not settled after billing, the NCWHA may pursue collection via Small Claims Court.
- 8. The listed stall and tack room fee covers Thursday night through Sunday afternoon. Early arrivals and late stays for horses need to be arranged beforehand with show management. Please contact Rhonda Azevedo. Please indicate your arrival date on the entry forms.
- 9. Should Northern California Walking Horse Association receive a bill for any early arrivals or late departures that were not collected, you will in turn be billed double the fee, along with a billing fee of \$30.00. By signing the entry form you agree to all of the rules set forth in this Show Premium.
- 10. Bedding is **not** provided for the stalls. Shavings are available for purchase at \$7/bale through The Equestrian Center at Rolling Hills Casino.
- 11. Management will do its best to honor your stabling requests on your entry forms. However as a reminder to all attending the horse show, stall assignments are created by the Show Office. The posted stall assignments are final, unless special permission is granted to change stall assignments. If anyone is found changing stall assignments without receiving approval from the show office, they are subject to a \$100 fine per stall assignment that has been changed. We are very sorry to have to impose this strict of a rule, however, moving just one stall assignment, without approval from the show office, can create complication and, if your stall had been prepared, the association may be charged for it even if it is not used. We appreciate everyone's cooperation and understanding.
- 12. Working out of trailers is permitted. You will, however, be charged \$15 per horse per day.

Show Rules:

- 1. All TWH classes will be conducted by the rules of the WHOA Rulebook (2014 version) and TWHBEA Versatility Rulebook (2010 and beyond), which will be available to view at the show office. The WHOA rulebook is available online at http://gwhea.com/wp-content/uploads/2014/04/WHOA-Pleasure-rulebook-2014.pdf. The TWHBEA Versatility Rulebook can be found at www.twhbea.com/programs/versatility.php. Any show rules that are different from what is listed in these rulebooks are specifically stated in this premium and will supersede any conflicting rules stated in either rulebook. Peruvian Paso classes will be conducted by the rules of the North American Peruvian Horse Association, available at https://www.napha.net/new/ShowRules/ShowRules.pdf. Rocky Mountain Horse classes will be conducted by the rules of the Rocky Mountain Horse Association, available at https://www.rmhorse.com/sites/default/files/judges/2017%20Rule%20Book%20w-Ads%20Removed.pdf. Cowboy Dressage classes and tests will abide by the Cowboy Dressage rule book. Tests and rules available at http://cowboydressageworld.com/.
- 2. Lite Shod classes at Oktoberfest shall be governed under the rules of the Lite Shod Pleasure division in the WHOA rulebook. The shoe in this division is limited the ½"x1".
- 3. Country Pleasure horses must be keg shod. Country Pleasure horses may be ridden by professionals in TWH Pleasure and OGB classes. **Country Pleasure divisional classes are still amateur only**.
- 4. All Day Pleasure is an **amateur only division**. All gaited breeds are eligible. **Horses owned by professional trainers or their immediate family are not eligible for this division, unless the horse is used EXCLUSIVELY as a lesson horse by the trainer.** Crossover of TWH between All Day Pleasure and other TWH divisions is **NOT** allowed. All

Day Pleasure horses may also be ridden in TWH Pleasure (if the horse is a registered TWH) and OGB classes <u>but must</u> <u>be ridden by an amateur rider.</u> Please see the WHOA rulebook for information on the standards of this division.

- 5. Cross entering between TWH divisions is not allowed. All TWH divisions are eligible to show in OGB and TWH Pleasure classes.
- 6. The maximum shoe size allowed in the SSH classes is a liteshod shoe (1/2"x1").
- 7. All classes are exclusively for the registered Tennessee Walking Horses, with the exception of the All Day Pleasure, OtGB, SSH, & OGB classes which are open to non-registered gaited horses.
- Class definitions: TWH Pleasure Division- Open to all Tennessee Walking Horses of all divisions. Riders may use two hands when riding in western tack in this division, regardless of horse age or division or bit type. OGB (Open Gaited Breed)- All gaited breeds are eligible to show in these classes. There are no shoeing restrictions (exception: OBG barefoot classes). Horses may be registered or unregistered. Horses will be judged against the standard of their breed or TWH division. Riders may use two hands when riding in western tack in this division, regardless of horse age or division or bit type. OtGB (Other Gaited Breed)- All gaited breeds EXCEPT Tennessee Walking Horses are eligible to show in these classes. Spotted Saddle Horses that are also registered Tennessee Walking Horses may enter OtGB classes but CANNOT cross enter into any TWH Pleasure or TWH divisional classes (lite shod, trail pleasure, country pleasure). Spotted Saddle Horses who are dual registered may cross enter in SSH classes. Horses may be registered or unregistered. Horses will be judged against the standard of their breed. Non-Gaited-Open to any horse that is not of a traditionally gaited breed and whose natural primary intermediate gait is the trot. Youth- Exhibitor is 17 years of age or under as of January 1, 2017. <u>Limit</u>- No more than 7 blue ribbons (1st place) won by horse/rider prior to the start of this show. Blue ribbons won when the horse/rider was the single entry in a class does not count toward the maximum total. The total does count all blue ribbons won in all HIO affiliated shows. Green As Grass- Horse or Rider is either in his or her first year of showing or has shown at fewer than five (5) shows lifetime. Green As Grass horses and riders must also fall under the definition of limit as above. Horses of Color-Open to horses of any unique color (Champagne, Buckskin, Palomino, Tobiano, Sabino, Roan, Gray, etc.). Chestnut, black, and bay horses are not eligible. Amateur Owned and Trained (AOT)- Horses must not have received professional training for 90 (ninety) days immediately preceding the show. AOT horses may not be ridden by a professional at any time on the show grounds. Amateur- Unless marked specifically as 18 and over, amateur classes are open to youth and adults who meet the definitions of an amateur as per the WHOA rulebook V H. Pro/Am-Trainer to ride the first direction, amateur exhibitors to ride the second direction. An amateur owned and trained horse may be ridden by two different amateur riders.
- 9. A versatility hi point award will be awarded to the entry who earns the most points in designated versatility classes. A reserve hi point award will be awarded to the entry with the next highest number of points. Points will be awarded based on placing (1st=6pts, 2nd=5pts, 3rd=4pts, 4th=3pts, 5th=2pts, participation=1pt.) and will follow the horse. A tie will be broken by most blue ribbons won. No preshow sign up is required and there is no fee to participate. The points will be awarded in classes 40-45 and 82-89. Points will follow the horse. Points will only be counted for one class in each division. So a horse can earn points in only one of the dressage, trail, barrel, and pole bending classes available, though horses may enter more than one class in a division. The show management will automatically count points in the class where the entry placed higher if both divisional classes were entered.
- 10. Open, amateur, and youth NCWHA members hi points will be awarded for the show. Points will follow the rider and the rider may use multiple horses. The rider must be an NCWHA member as of the <u>beginning</u> of the Oktoberfest Horse Show. There is no fee to participate. No pre-entries are required. All classes are eligible. Points will be awarded based on placings as follows: 1st=5pts, 2nd=4pts, 3rd=3pts, 4th=2pts, 5th=1pt. Ties will be broken by the most blue ribbons won.
- 11. Stallions shall be barred from Youth Exhibitors Classes.
- 12. The Leadline class is open to riders 6 and under. **All entries must be lead by an adult exhibitor**. One or two side walkers are acceptable as needed for rider safety.
- 13. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any class with less that three (3) horses entered.
- 14. When classes are entered and the horse does not go into the class, the class must be paid for unless the class is canceled or a scratch slip is filled out at the show office prior to the start of the class. No refund will be issued when the horse is excused by the three person panel, excused by the judge, or self-excused once entering the ring.
- 15. Gate holds (3 minute maximum) will be granted for just cause upon notification of the Gate Person.
- 16. To qualify for a championship class, the horse must have been shown and judged in a corresponding qualifying class.
- 17. The judge will hand out "golden ticket" cards to entries during the show (ten cards total). Only those entries receiving cards will be eligible to show back in the final Overall Championship class.
- 18. Time-outs may be granted by the judge when the exhibitor pulls into the center of the arena. Time-outs will be granted for replacement of shoes, replacement of broken equipment, or in other instances where the judge finds valid reason. An exhibitor may be excused from the ring by pulling into the center of the arena and obtaining permission from the judge or ringmaster to be excused. Entries that are excused prior to the completion of the class will be deemed not judged and therefore that class will not qualify the entry for a championship class.
- 19. All exhibitors, owners, and trainers must comply with the Horse Protection Act and cooperate fully with representatives enforcing that Act. Horses with any bilateral hair loss, scarring, callous, or granulated tissue on the pasterns or coronet area indicative of the practice of soring, showing signs of lameness, or any way of going that is considered "bad image" will be excused from classes entered and may be asked to leave the grounds. All

entries must be inspected by the DQP. In addition, concerns of possible HPA violations may be brought by the judge or show management or by exhibitors filing complaints as per the WHOA rulebook and will be subjected to additional inspection. Show management may ask any entries in violation of the HPA to leave the grounds. Any person with <u>ANY</u> HIO suspension or disqualification is in effect during the show for violation of any provision of the Horse Protection Act may not participate in this show in any capacity other than as a spectator. Prohibited activities include: showing or exhibition of horses, hauling horses to and from the show, or caring for horses on the grounds. Any suspended person must restrict themselves to the grandstand, rest room, and concession areas and may not linger were horses are kept.

- 20. Shoe sizes will be checked by the DQP only if there are questions brought by the judge, show management, or other exhibitors as to whether a horse is wearing shoes legal for the class the horse will be exhibited in. Please make sure the WHOA rules and show rules are reviewed to ensure horses are correctly shod for each division. There will not be an onsite farrier this year. There will be individuals who can do basic shoeing available at the show. In addition, the contact information of a local farrier will be available at the show office. There will also be a local vet contact information available at the show office.
- 21. No chains or other action devices are allowed on any horses at any time on the show grounds.
- 22. Bands are not allowed on any horses at Oktoberfest at any time.
- 23. <u>Helmets are REQUIRED for any exhibitor 13 years of age or younger AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED.</u>
 Helmets are REQUIRED for any exhibitor 17 years of age or younger while participating in timed event classes.
 The Oktoberfest Show Management and Show Committee reserve the right to prohibit a youth from riding on the grounds if these rules are violated.
- 24. Dogs accompanying spectators and exhibitors must be kept on a leash at all times. This is for the safety of the all people on the grounds, as well as for the dog itself. If dog owners do not cooperate with this rule, the Oktoberfest Show Management and Show Committee reserve the right to require the owner to confine their dog for the duration of the show.
- 25. The Northern California Walking Horse Association, Show Committee, Show Management and the Equestrian Center at Rolling Hills Casino will not be responsible for any articles that are lost, destroyed or stolen, although every precaution will be taken to protect property and exhibitors. The show and/or management will not be liable for any injury sustained in any way to exhibitors, animals, employees or spectators. The warm up arena is not open to visitors; you must be an owner, rider, trainer, or groom to be in the area.
- 26. Show Management and Show Committee reserves the right to accept or refuse service and/or deny entries and/or cancel entries, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel premiums without claims for damage. Additionally, any individual who exhibits disorderly conduct or non-sportsman-like conduct may be asked to leave the grounds and all high points associated with that person (individual points or horse points) will be null and void. No refunds will be made to those who are asked to leave the grounds for disorderly conduct, non-sportsman-like conduct, or suspected HPA violations.
- 27. Alcoholic beverages are allowed on the show grounds. However, public drunkenness, aggressive, dangerous, or threatening behaviors toward any other person on the show grounds, show officials, show exhibitors, or guests WILL NOT BE TOLERATED and the offending individual may be asked to leave the grounds and may be barred from additional participation in the Oktoberfest Horse Show at the discretion of the NCWHA Board, Oktoberfest Show Management, and/or officials from the Rolling Hills Casio. In addition, law enforcement may be contacted in order to keep the peace and public safety for all individuals and animals.
- 28. BY ATTENDING THE OKTOBERFEST HORSE SHOW AS AN EXHIBITOR, SPECTATOR, OR GUEST, ALL INDIVIDUALS HEREBY AGREE TO THE RULES AND JURISDICTION OF THE NWCHA, WHOA, ROLLING HILLS CASINO, AND OKTOBERFEST HORSE SHOW.
