## Versatility High Point Award

This year there will be a Youth and an Adult Versatility High Point.

No preshow sign up is required and there are no specific rail class requirements. The points will be awarded in classes that start with a "V" However, points will only be counted for one class in each division, even though you are welcome to enter both classes. ie: So a horse can earn points in class 32 or 33 (but not both). Points will follow the horse. All versatility classes including Halter and Cowboy Dressage remain only \$15 each to enter!

### High Points, NCWHA Members Hi Point and NCWHA Member classes

High points and reserve high points will be awarded in every division. To be eligible for any NCWHA member class, an exhibitor must currently be a member. If the rider is not a member prior to entering the class the points collected in class will not count towards Year end high point. Mayfest will be awarding an Adult NCWHA Member Hi Point award and a Youth NCWHA Member Hi Point Award. To be eligible, the rider must be an NCWHA member prior to the start of the show. Points follow the member and can be earned on multiple horses. A new NCWHA member class has been added. *Novice member*, is defined as an amateur member who has not won an end year NCWHA high point award. Further, I would take an opportunity to remind folks in the rules that for NCWHA high point classes, the same horse cannot be shown in more than one class and have points count. **Helmet requirements set forth here:**

Per our insurance: **All riders 14 years of age and under are required to wear protective helmets whenever riding and or sitting on a horse and/or showing on the horse show grounds at all times. NO EXCEPTIONS! All riders 18 years of age and younger are required to wear protective helmets when participating in timed event classes. All riders of all ages are strongly encouraged to wear protective helmets while showing, particularly in timed event classes. If a rider decides not to wear a protective helmet, that rider agrees to recognize the risk of head or other injury and accept all liability for any injury. The rider (or parent if under 18 years of age) must initial here to indicate that the helmet requirements were read and understood:** \_\_\_\_\_

**Release of Liability and Indemnification:**

In consideration of participating in the Northern California Walking Horse Association's Mayfest Horse Show (the "Show"), which is being held on May 4-6, 2018 at the Murieta Equestrian Center, Rancho Murieta, California, I hereby release NCWHA, the Show Manager, Murieta Equestrian Center, and all of their directors, agents, employees or any of their representatives or assigns (collectively, "Indemnites"), from any and all liability for any act of negligence or want of ordinary care on the part of Indemnites. I hereby waive, release and discharge Indemnites from any and all claims of liability for injury or damage to myself, my animals or my property arising out of any claims of liability for injury resulting from the Show, which shall be binding upon my executors, heirs or assigns.

I expressly waive any rights I may have under California Civil Code Section 1542, which states that "A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him, might have materially affected his settlement with the debtor."

I agree that I will indemnify and hold harmless Indemnites against all claims, demands and causes of action, including court costs and actual attorneys' fees incurred, arising from any court proceedings or other causes of actions brought by or prosecuted for my benefit, in which this Release of Liability and Indemnification is upheld.

I acknowledge that horseback riding is a sport which carries inherent risks of injury and damage to me, the Horse and my property. I knowingly assume all risks of participating in horse-related activities and horseback riding, whether known or unknown, including, but not limited to, injuries, death or property damage from: mounting, dismounting, riding, walking, grooming, feeding, use of facilities or riding arena, falling off a horse, riding without a helmet, or otherwise relating to horseback riding or otherwise use and control of, or lack thereof, of the horse ridden or any horse present at the Show. Those not signing entries are banned from riding on the show grounds.

1. Pre-entries must be postmarked by the closing date of **Saturday, April 28, 2018**. Pre-entries may also be made through [www.horseshowtime.com](http://www.horseshowtime.com). Pre-entries may pay for entries by check if they are sending in an entry blank or by PayPal if entries are made via [www.horseshowtime.com](http://www.horseshowtime.com). Pre-entries also have the option of leaving an open check with the show office. The show closing date not only allows time for the office staff to prepare your entries properly, it also gives us the information needed by the fairgrounds to prepare stalls. By contract we must give them the amount of stalls needed several weeks before the show. Please try to get your entries in early.
2. Any original entries made after the closing date will be assessed the fee of \$30 per horse. **No exceptions.**
3. Payment in full or a signed blank check must be included with the entry to cover all show fees (Make checks payable to NCWHA Mayfest). Blank checks may be given to the show office at the show but must be received prior to obtaining the entry show number. Show numbers will not be issued until the entry is complete, including NCWHA signed release.
4. Scratches and adds may be made at the show without an additional fee once an original entry is made. **In order to prepare for each session, NO ORIGINAL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE START OF EACH SESSION. NO EXCEPTIONS.** Please also try to ensure all adds, scratches, and rider changes are made 30 minutes prior to each session.
5. The Trainer of the horse must sign all entries. If you do your own training, you must sign as the trainer.
6. Please list all riders for each horse on the entry form. If additional room is needed, please write it on a separate sheet and staple it to the entry form.
7. Persons failing to pay their bill at the show will be charged a \$50.00 service fee. A \$50 service fee plus additional bank charges will be added to all returned checks. If accounts are not settled after billing, the NCWHA may pursue collection via Small Claims Court.
8. The listed stall and tack room fee covers Friday night through Sunday afternoon. **Early arrivals and late stays for horses need to be arranged beforehand with show management. Please contact Rhonda Azevedo or Nicole Schoppe.** Please indicate your arrival date on the entry forms.
9. Should Northern California Walking Horse Association receive a bill for any early arrivals or late departures that were not collected, you will in turn be billed double the fee, along with a billing fee of \$30.00. By signing the entry form you agree to all of the rules set forth in this Show Premium.
10. All stalls **WILL NOT COME WITH BEDDING.** PLEASE PRE-ORDER Bedding, make arrangements with show management ASAP.
11. Management will do its best to honor your stabling requests on your entry forms. However as a reminder to all attending the horse show, stall assignments are created by the Show Management. The posted stall assignments are final, unless special permission is granted to change stall assignments. If anyone is found changing stall assignments without receiving approval from the show office, they are subject to a \$100 fine per stall assignment that has been changed. We are very sorry to have to impose this strict of a rule, however, moving just one stall assignment, without approval from the show office, can create a stall chart nightmare and if your stall had been prepared the association may be charged for it even if it is not used. We appreciate everyone's cooperation and understanding.
12. Working out of trailers is permitted. You will, however, be charged \$25 per horse, per day.

**Show Rules:**

1. **All classes will be conducted by the rules of the PHWA Rulebook and TWHBEA Versatility Rulebook (2010 and beyond),** which will be available to view at the show office. The NWHA rulebook is also available online at <https://www.nwha.com/> The TWHBEA Versatility Rulebook can be found at [www.twhbea.com/programs/versatility.php](http://www.twhbea.com/programs/versatility.php). Any show rules that are different from what is listed in these rulebooks are specifically stated in this premium and will supersede any conflicting rules stated in either rulebook. <http://www.pwhaca.org/files/127202980.pdf>
2. Cross entering between All Day Pleasure and Country Pleasure divisions are allowed. All TWH divisions are eligible to show in OGB. TWH's Planation Pleasure divisions can cross enter in PLANTAION LITESHOD and PLANTATION PLEASURE, as long as they have the shoeing specifications held by the LITE SHOD division rules.
3. **Class definitions:** OGB (Open Gaited Breed)- All gaited breeds are eligible to show in these classes. There are no shoeing restrictions (exception: OBG barefoot classes). Horses may be registered or unregistered. Horses will be judged against the standard of their breed or TWH division. Horses will be judged against the standard of their breed. Youth-Exhibitor is 17 years of age or under as of January 1, 2018. Limit- No more than 7 blue ribbons (1<sup>st</sup> place) won by horse/rider prior to the start of this show. Blue ribbons won when the horse/rider was the single entry in a class does not

count toward the maximum total. The total does count all blue ribbons won in all HIO affiliated shows. Green As Grass- Horse or Rider is either in his or her first year of showing or has shown at fewer than five (5) shows lifetime. Green As Grass horses and riders must also fall under the definition of limit as above. Horses of Color- Open to horses of any unique color (Champagne, Buckskin, Palomino, Tobiano, Sabino, Roan, Gray, etc.). Chestnut, black, and bay horses are not eligible. Amateur Owned and Trained (AOT)- Horses must not have received professional training for 90 (ninety) days immediately preceding the show. AOT horses may not be ridden by a professional at any time on the show grounds. Amateur- Unless marked specifically 18 and over, amateur classes are open to youth and adults who meet the definitions of an amateur as per the NWWHA rulebook. Pro/Am- Trainer to ride the first direction, amateur exhibitors to ride the second direction. Denver/Jr. is a horse that is 5yrs or under in age.

4. A Versatility hi point award will be awarded to the entry who earns the most points in designated versatility classes. Points will be awarded based on placing (1<sup>st</sup>=6pts, 2<sup>nd</sup>=5pts, 3<sup>rd</sup>=4pts, 4<sup>th</sup>=3pts, 5<sup>th</sup>=2pts, participation=1pt.) and will follow the horse. No preshow sign up is required and there is no fee to participate. The points will be awarded in all the classes marked with a (\*). However, points will only be counted for one class in each division (class 93/95 or 92/94). The show management will automatically count points in the class where the entry placed higher if both divisional classes were entered. Points for the versatility hi point may be earned by both team participants in the Ribbon Race class
5. Adult and youth NWWHA members hi points will be awarded. Points will follow the rider and the rider may use multiple horses. The rider must be an NWWHA member as of the beginning of the MayFest Horse Show. There is no fee to participate. Each rider must pre-declare classes for which they wish to use for show high point on the designated form before the start of the show. All Show high points will be calculated by the computer, no pre entry necessary. Halter classes will count as a versatility class.. Points will be awarded based on placings as follows: 1<sup>st</sup>=6pts, 2<sup>nd</sup>=5pts, 3<sup>rd</sup>=4pts, 4<sup>th</sup>=3pts, 5<sup>th</sup>=2pts, participation=1pt. Ties will be broken by the most blue ribbons won. If there is still a tie, then the member who beat the most entries in their declared classes will win the award.
6. Stallions shall be barred from Youth Exhibitors Classes, but are aloud in LADIES TO RIDE CLASSES with rider over 18.
7. The Leadline class is open to riders 6 and under. **All entries must be lead by an adult exhibitor.** One or two side walkers are acceptable as needed for rider safety.
8. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any class with less that three (3) horses entered.
9. When classes are entered and the horse does not go into the class, the class must be paid for unless the class is canceled or a scratch slip is filled out at the show office prior to the start of the class. No refund will be issued when the horse is excused by the three person panel, excused by the judge, or self-excused once entering the ring.
10. Gate holds (3 minute maximum) will be granted for just cause upon notification of the Gate Person.
11. To qualify for a championship class, the horse must have been shown and judged in the matching qualifying class.
12. All horses that place 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in any model classes qualify to show back in the model championship.
13. All horses that place 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in any championship class qualify for the overall grand championship class. Horses who have not shown in a championship class are not eligible for the overall grand championship class.
14. Time-outs may be granted by the judge when the exhibitor pulls into the center of the arena. Time-outs will be granted for replacement of shoes, replacement of broken equipment, or in other instances where the judge finds valid reason. An exhibitor may be excused from the ring by pulling into the center of the arena and obtaining permission from the judge or ringmaster to be excused. Entries that are excused prior to the completion of the class will be deemed no judged and therefore that class will not qualify the entry for a championship class.
15. **There will not be a DQP on the show grounds. All exhibitors, owner, and trainers must comply with the Horse Protection Act and cooperate fully with representatives enforcing that Act. Horses with any bilateral hair loss, scarring, callous, or granulated tissue on the pasterns or coronet area indicative of the practice of soring, showing signs of lameness, or any way of going that is considered "bad image" will be excused from classes entered and will be asked to leave the grounds. Concerns of possible HPA violations may be brought by the judge or show management or by exhibitors filing complaints as per the PWWHA RULE BOOK. Horses suspected of HPA violations will be will be inspected by a three person panel. A vet may be called in to determine if the unsoundness is secondary to a medical issue or HPA violation. The expense of the vet visit will be charged to the owner of the horse unless the vet is requested by the three person panel. Any person with ANY HIO suspension or disqualification is in effect during the show for violation of any provision of the Horse Protection Act may not participate in this show in any capacity other than as a spectator. Prohibited activities include: showing or exhibition of horses, hauling horses to and from the show, or caring for horses on the grounds. Any suspended person must restrict themselves to the grandstand, rest room, and concession areas and may not linger were horses are kept.**
16. Shoe sizes will be checked by the ring steward. Please make sure the PWWHA rules are reviewed to ensure horses are correctly shod for each division. See Shoeing Rules and Regulations below from PWWHA rule book:

### **PLANTATION PLEASURE SHOE RESTRICTIONS**

The shoe must be of one piece and must not exceed 1/2 inch in thickness and no wider than 1 inch except for the caulk which must be no thicker than one (1) inch and the turn back shall not exceed one (1) inch in length. The shoe must not extend more than 1/4 inch beyond the toe. Borium is permitted on the caulks of the shoes but the thickness of the shoe and the caulk with the borium must not exceed 7/8 of an inch. **THIS IS THE MAXIMUM SHOE SIZE ALLOWANCE FOR ALL FOUR FEET.**

### **PLANTATION LITE SHOD SHOE RESTRICTIONS**

The shoe must be of one piece and must not exceed 3/8 inch in thickness and no wider than 3/4 inch except for the caulk which must be no thicker than 3/4 inch and the turn back shall not exceed one (1) inch in length. Borium is permitted on the caulks of the shoes but the thickness of the shoe and the caulk with the borium must not exceed 7/8 of an inch. The shoe must not extend more than 1/4 inch beyond the toe. **THIS IS THE MAXIMUM SHOE SIZE ALLOWANCE FOR ALL FOUR FEET.**

### **PLANTATION TRAIL PLEASURE SHOE RESTRICTIONS**

The shoe must be of one piece and must not exceed 3/8 inch in thickness and no wider than 3/4 inch except for the caulk which must be no thicker than 3/4 inch and the turn back shall not exceed one (1) inch in length. Borium is permitted on the caulks of the shoes but the thickness of the shoe and the caulk with the borium must not exceed 7/8 of an inch. The shoe must not extend more than 1/4 inch beyond the toe. **THIS IS THE MAXIMUM SHOE SIZE ALLOWANCE FOR ALL FOUR FEET.**

### **PLANTATION COUNTRY PLEASURE SHOE RESTRICTIONS**

The Country Pleasure must be a factory made, stamped keg shoe of one piece and must not exceed 3/8 inch in thickness and 3/4 inch width (poured or cast) hot or cold rolled steel or aluminum shoe. Only flat or poured type keg heeled shoe options are allowed. Keg shoes manufactured with grabs or weighted toes are prohibited. Only clips drawn from the shoe itself are permitted. No additional material can be added or removed from the keg shoe. The keg shoe shall not extend past the toe. The shoe is not to extend beyond the bulb of the horse's heel when a perpendicular line is drawn from the bulb of the horse's heel to the ground. Poured or cast clips are permitted if poured in the original cast (may not be welded on). Poured or cast caulks are permitted if poured in the original cast (may not be welded or turned). **THIS IS THE MAXIMUM SHOE SIZE ALLOWANCE FOR ALL FOUR FEET.**

### **ALL DAY PLEASURE SHOE RESTRICTIONS**

The shoe must be of one piece and must not exceed 1/2 inch in thickness and no wider than 1 inch except for the caulk which must be no thicker than one (1) inch and the turn back shall not exceed one (1) inch in length. The shoe must not extend more than 1/4 inch beyond the toe. Borium is permitted on the caulks of the shoes but the thickness of the shoe and the caulk with the borium must not exceed 7/8 of an inch. **THIS IS THE MAXIMUM SHOE SIZE ALLOWANCE FOR ALL FOUR FEET.**

**HOOF BANDS AND CLIPS** The use of hoof bands and welded clips are not permitted anywhere on the show grounds. Clips that are drawn from the shoe itself are permitted. No additional weight or material shall be allowed on or in the hoof other than the shoe and appropriate nail.

**Shoes only allowed on horse.** Pads of any kind are prohibited, therapeutic or otherwise.

No devices or enhancements of any kind added. No therapeutic shoes (heart bar, egg bar, natural balance etc.) The reasoning behind this being, while we understand the need for therapeutic shoes, given the TWH unique situation they can be used adversely (weight added, pressure added).

17. The Northern California Walking Horse Association, Show Committee, Show Management and the Murieta Equestrian Center will not be responsible for any articles that are lost, destroyed or stolen, although every precaution will be taken to protect property and exhibitors. The show and/or management will not be liable for any injury sustained in any way to exhibitors, animals, employees or spectators. The warm up arena is not open to visitors; you must be an owner, rider, trainer, or groom to be in the area.
18. Show Management reserves the right to accept or refuse service and/or deny entries and/or cancel entries, disqualify exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel premiums without claims for damage. Additionally, **any individual who exhibits disorderly conduct or non-sportsman-like conduct may be asked to leave the grounds** and all high points associated with that person (individual points or horse points) will be null and void. No refunds will be made to those who are asked to leave the grounds for disorderly conduct, non-sportsman-like conduct, or suspected HPA violations. **BY YOUR PRESENCE ON THE MURIETA EQUESTRIAN CENTER AT THE MAYFEST HORSE SHOW, EITHER AS AN EXHIBITOR OR A SPECTATOR, YOU AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE RULES AS LISTED.**
19. **COWBOY DRESSAGE GAITED TESTS** can be found at [www.cowboydressageworld.com](http://www.cowboydressageworld.com)  
Using gaited tests: W/IG 2 & 3 and W/IG/L 2, Classes will be judged based on CD rules.

**Facility Rules:**

1. Please clean up after yourself and your horse. Areas left messy after the show will be charged to the organization and subsequently you will be billed for whatever the facility charges (Minimum \$40), plus an additional billing fee of \$30. You must leave the facility in the same condition that you found it.
2. Horses may only be washed in designated wash racks areas only.
3. Absolutely **NO PARKING** on the roadways or access ways is allowed on the fair grounds. All trailers & vehicles shall be limited to designated parking areas so as not to block the fire lanes. A tow truck may be called if there are violations.
4. Horses are only allowed in the barn, warm up arena and in the main arena only.
5. No riding in the barns, on the lawns or on the roadways.
6. **Dogs accompanying exhibitors and trainers must be managed at all times. Owners must clean up after their pet. If any complaints are filed, the pet will be required to be confined at all times.**
7. No riding of motorcycles, bicycles, ATV's or horses in the barns. Please observe the 10 MPH speed limit. Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to drive any motorized vehicle
8. You must leave the facility in the same condition as you found it. Landscape materials used outside your barn area must be removed and the area swept clean. **Vandalism, damage or displacement of Murieta Equestrian Center property or the property of any trainer, owner or exhibitors will result in a \$50.00 fine to all individuals involved in addition to any charges for damages.**
9. Public drunkenness, aggressive, dangerous, or threatening behaviors toward any other person on the show grounds, show officials, show exhibitors, or guests **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED** and the offending individual may be asked to leave the grounds and may be barred from additional participation in the Mayfest Horse Show at the discretion of the NCWHA Board and/or officials from the Murieta Equestrian Center. In addition, law enforcement may be contacted in order to keep the peace and public safety for all individuals and animals. By attending the Mayfest Horse Show as an exhibitor, spectator, or guest, all individuals hereby agree to the rule and jurisdiction of the NCWHA, 2018 NWHA rule book, Murieta Equestrian Center, and Mayfest Horse Show.
